

MONTGOMERY COUNTY UTILITY DISTRICT No 8

Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 8 was formed September 12, 1972. Since 1972, the district has annexed La Point Condominiums, Waters Edge and Hunters Landing all on River road. The District is empowered to purchase, operate and maintain all facilities, plants and improvements necessary to provide water, sanitary sewer service, storm sewer drainage, irrigation, solid waste collection and disposal, including recycling, parks and recreational facilities for the residents of the District, to contract for or employ its own peace officers with powers to make arrest and to establish, operate and maintain a fire department to perform all fire fighting activities within the district. The Board of Directors held its first meeting on December 27, 1972, and the first bonds were sold on September 17, 1973. Proceeds from these bonds were used to construct water wells, distribution systems, and Water Reclamation Plant. MUD 8 currently operates without long-term debt.

Montgomery County Municipality District No. 9 was formed subsequent to MUD 8. Since both districts serve parts of Walden on Lake Conroe, it has been advantageous for the Districts to enter into mutually beneficial agreements providing for interconnection of potable water supply lines, joint use of the water reclamation plant (operated by MUD 8) and installation and operation of a computer control system (SCADA) for potable water systems.

MUD 8 and MUD 9 pay a Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District (LSGCD) 2008 imposed fee of \$0.07 per 1,000 gallons of groundwater pumped. This fee (MUD 8 was \$19,270 in 2007) enables LSGCD to fulfill its planning and regulatory functions. As LSGCD or other organizations begin implementation of the groundwater conversion to surface water plan, this fee is expected to increase dramatically. MUD 8 normally meets in public session on the second Wednesday of each month with an official Agenda posted on the MUD8 web site: <http://www.montgomerycountymud8.com> and also on the front doors of the Walden Yacht Club and the WCIA office. The meeting is normally held at the Walden Yacht Club at 9am.

Five Directors of MUD 8 are elected to four year terms in staggered years. Election takes place in May and Directors are sworn into office in June. Current MUD 8 Directors are Roy McCoy, Roy Harpold, Bob Leasure, Dan Davis, and Arch Payne. MUD 8 Directors and Staff welcomes your attendance and input at District meetings.
